Submission Criteria and Requirements

The Michigan Aviation Education Foundation (MAEF) Scholarship Program was established for the purpose of providing financial assistance for the advancement of education and training in aviation or aeronautics within the State of Michigan. Scholarships may be awarded to individual residents of the state of Michigan whose educational goals meet the MAEF mission and program guidelines. This shall include:

- A. Initial or advanced Private or Commercial Pilot training
- B. Technical training in an Aviation, Aeronautics or Aerospace related field
- C. College education in an Aviation, Aeronautics or Aerospace related field
- D. Aviation, Aeronautics or Aerospace Historical Education Programs
- E. Educational programs that directly promote and advance Aviation, Aeronautics or Aerospace Education in Michigan
- F. Participation as a student in research projects directly association with the advancement of Aviation or Aerospace.

Applicant Criteria/Requirements include:

1. Applicants must be Michigan residents, or an organization incorporated or registered and based in the State of Michigan. Proof of residency such as a current driver's license or other government issued photo ID or legal documents must be provided with the application in order to be considered.
2. Applicants must submit a one-page written essay with their application addressing the selection factors and describing their training or educational goals, and specifically identify how the scholarship money will be used to accomplish or advance those goals.
3. Applicants must submit with their application three (3) letters of recommendation from persons (not family members) or organizations who can vouch for their competence and serious intent to complete the education, training or project for which grant funding is being sought.
4. Applicants must be able to complete the education, training, or specified portion of the education or training for which MAEF funds are being sought within one year of the time the MAEF scholarship is awarded. Verification of completion is required by reporting to the MAEF President or other current trustee.
5. Applicants requesting funds for training and college education must complete all prerequisite training required to enter the aviation, aeronautics, or aerospace related program for which funding herein is being sought before he/she will receive the MAEF scholarship award.
6. Applicants who are current high school or college students must complete the section of the application pertaining to their Grade Point Average and/or provide other documented proof thereof.

7. Applicants seeking funds for training/educational courses must submit documentation from the training or academic institution identifying how the money will be applied to include a summary of the cost of the training; e.g., flight school training, tuition cost, etc. Disbursement of the scholarship funds will be made directly to the institution or flight school of the applicant's choosing and an agreement must be signed by the recipient and the school prior to issuance of funds.
8. Applicants applying for scholarships for pilot training must submit a copy of their medical certificate, last 8-months logbook entries and other endorsements relating to the training.

Documentation and Selection Factors:

Essay and application documents shall address -

- Description of your educational training/educational need or goal;
- What has been done already to advance your training/educational goals;
- How the MAEF scholarship would help advance or achieve your training/educational goals;
- Previous educational scholarships, grants and awards you have received and how those were applied to support or achieve your training or educational goal;
- Your significant or unique aviation-related achievements;
- Your ability and feasibility to accomplish your training/educational goals.
- Financial need and costs involved in achieving your training/educational goals, as known, for which scholarship funds are being sought; and
- Your involvement in aviation, aeronautics, or aerospace related activities.

Selection will be based on -

- Direct relationship of the training/education to the MAEF mission, purpose and program requirements;
- Benefit of successful achievement of the students training/education goals to aviation, aeronautics and aerospace in Michigan; and
- Evidence of the ability and feasibility to accomplish the training/educational goals.
